

## General Information

You will be sent information about the course which includes **what you need** to bring with you, and details about the **venue**. To avoid any unnecessary cost, please **don't buy any materials** or text books until you know the course is running. We usually make decisions a week or two before the course is due to start, so if you don't hear from us then your course will run.

You will gain the most from your course if you **attend regularly**, but if you are unable to attend a session, please let us know. We are unable to offer refunds for this. If your tutor is unable to run a session, we will let you know as soon as we can, and arrange another session.

In cases of **severe weather**, information will be available on our website.

There is a **no smoking policy** on all of our college sites

**Mobile phones** should be turned off or set to silent during classes.

There are **First Aid Boxes** at all our venues and appropriately trained staff available to help in an emergency situation. Please report any accidents or near misses to your tutor or other ACRES staff.

Our **safeguarding** policy states that we cannot allow any under 19 year olds to attend any course. This includes children of learners.

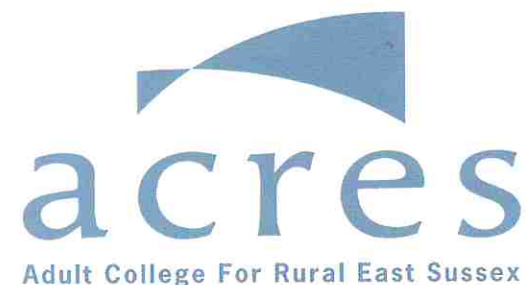
